



2023 has been a successful year for organizational growth and development. We have started a great journey to transform UWMC. as we were recognized by the state president of Malawi, the "Zikomo Award" for the great work we are doing in our community.

During 2023, UWMC introduced a new program targeting youths in sexual reproductive health education and counseling. Our target was to reach 10,000 youths in secondary schools in Mzimba district.

We continued doing out reach clinics in rural areas of Mzimba to cover the gap of unmet need for family planning services and conducting routing immunization schedules to under-five children including anthropometric measurements to assess nutrition status of children and elderly people in the communities..

We finished setting up the laboratory for easy diagnosing of different conditions in order to improve patient outcomes.

UWMC is now better equipped for facing different kinds of potential challenges. In this regard, we thank our funders for their support by making sure that the clinic is running smoothly.

we will continue providing a safe space for sexual reproductive health services including maternal and child health care.

Uchembere Wabwino Maternity provides clinical specialized sexual reproductive health services at an affordable price. We offer comprehensive package of sexual reproductive health services such as Maternal and Child health services, Under-Five clinic, Family planning, diagnostic test and sexual reproductive health education and counseling to young Adolescents in Secondary Schools. We also conduct community out reach visits to reach out to the last mile where people cannot access health care services. We do this by visiting the communities once in a month at a designed health post in rural settings of Mzimba. Our aim is to bring the services closer to the people in their communities.



OUR VISION: To provide equal access to safe and appropriate sexual reproductive health services to women across Malawi regardless of their social economic status.



OUR MISSION:To provide a safe place for delivery for women, empower young people through sexual reproductive health education and counseling and improve access to information and family planning services.



OUR WORK

We provide education to youths in secondary schools about adolescent reproductive health and rights.

Our target audience is teenagers (boys and girls)

Age: 10years-14 years 1st category

14years -20years 2nd category

we have 10 secondary schools which we do our programs

5 clubs have been formulated in the schools.

Maternal and Child Health care

Uchembere Wabwino Maternity provides out patient services including labour and delivery services and under-five clinic.

On average per month we conduct 6 deliveries and mothers who come for antenatal care clinic per month are 25.

under-five children per month we see 300.

Total deliveries in 2023: 72

Total Antenatal care mothers: 300

Total under-five Clinic:3600

Total Out Patient clients (male & female):2160



Outreach clinic

We conduct outreach clinics every month to the three health post that we were allocated (Chankhanga, Enukwenu, Elangeni). The primary services that are being provided include: Family planning services, growth monitoring and immunizations to under-five children, Cervical cancer screening, antenatal care, HIV testing and counseling. and STI management.

Family Planning: 2800

Under-five growth monitoring:1023

Under-two Immunizations:900

Cervical Cancer screening: 58

HIV testing & Counseling:128

STI Management: 50



IMPACT

Through our outreach clinic programs, many women have access to reproductive health care services within their reach. This makes women to be productive in their communities as they find enough time to take care of their families and work well in farms as the distance to travel to access health care facility is reduced including transportation.




IMPACT

PROGRAM UPDATES



Since Malawi has high rate of teenage pregnancies with 35% (MDHS-2016), we are continuing with our youth programs in various secondary schools, both government and private institutions.

We have also established an entrepreneurship component in the youth clubs that have been formulated for sustainability of the projects.

In order to reduce maternal complications, in 2024, we plan to finalize on our theater project, whereby emergency caesarean sections will be conducted to save lives.

we also plan to include innovation for disseminating information about SRHR using a mobile application in 2024


